Student Timetables for Next

The bookroom will be open weekdays June 20-28, 2018 from 8:30-4:00 pm daily. All text books and locks must returned to the book room during exam week. Students will be charged for books NOT returned. Lockers need to be cleaned out BEFORE 3:30 on June 28th. PE lockers before June 20th.

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LOCKDOWN REVIEW

Each year WCHS reviews and practices its Emergency Response procedures. Below is a quick summary of what to expect when the school undergoes an Evacuation; Shelter-In-Place; or Lockdown.

Students

Evacuation: What to Expect

- ♦ There is a possible danger INSIDE the school (fire, gas leak, chemical spill etc.).
- Students will be escorted by staff to a safe location away from the school.
- ♦ If required, students will go to our primary evacuation site (drill hall) or if this is not possible, students will proceed to our secondary site (Clear Vista School).
- Students may be released using our Student Release protocol.

Shelter In Place: What to Expect

- There is an ENVIRONMENTAL emergency in close proximity to the school or outside the school. Examples can include: a dangerous goods spill, tornado, wildfire.
- ♦ If the threat is immediate, school and students will gather into safer spaces, such as away from outside walls and large vented areas.
- ♦ Access to the school will depend on the emergency.
- ♦ This protocol will continue until the School Principal or Law Enforcement issues the ALL CLEAR.

Lockdown: What to Expect

- A lockdown protocol is initiated when there is an immediate THREAT OF VIOLENCE to students and staff INSIDE the building.
- ♦ The main objective is to protect the maximum number of people behind LOCKED DOORS.
- ◆ In a lockdown situation, students and staff will be locked in secure areas and the school will NOT operate as normal. Students will be directed to turn off all cellular devices. No one will be allowed in or out of the school.

Parents

Evacuation: What to Expect

- Parents may not always be notified immediately when the Evacuation is initiated. If the incident requires students remain away from the school for a period of time, parents will be notified.
- ♦ Updates will be provided on the school website and the school's social media accounts (Facebook, Twitter).

Shelter In Place: What to Expect

- This protocol will continue until the School Principal or Law Enforcement issues the ALL CLEAR.
- Parents may not always be notified immediately when a Shelter-In-Place protocol is initiated (i.e. wildlife on the school grounds).
- Should the level of danger be deemed high, a notification with instructions will be sent to parents using the division's communication system.

Lockdown: What to Expect

- It may not always be possible to send out information until after the incident has ended.
- Once it is safe to do so, a message will be sent to all parents using the school's website, the school's social medi accounts (Facebook, Twitter) and our email communication system.
- Our first priority will be to ensure the safety of students while cooperating fully with the RCMP.
- ♦ Only vague details can be provided regarding the incident until the RCMP completes their investigation.

Reminder: On **June 12, 2018** at 5:00 pm, Wetaskiwin Regional Public Schools will launch the **SchoolMessenger Communicate Campaign** that will allow parents to "opt in" via text messaging - Short Message Service (SMS). This will allow the division and schools to send mass notifications to parents and staff for emergencies, incidents or other important events taking place in the schools or across the District. It will also give schools the ability to communicate with families via text messages at no charge to you.

You will receive an opt in message on your cell phone if you are a parent or guardian to one of our students and your cell phone number was provided to your child's school.

Recipients have to reply "Y" or "Yes" to the invitation text message to "Opt-in".
