Students in GOALS, RLS & ALS do not have to come to registration; they will register in their classroom on the first day of school.

#### **GOWN RETURN**

Gowns & V-stoles must be returned in good condition to the WCHS Gym following the graduation ceremony, or to the school office by Monday, May 27th @ 9:00 am

Late Return of Gown: Returning the gown/v-stole late will result in a \$20.00 courier cost fee charged to the student's account

**Failure to Return Gown**: Failure to return the gown & v-stole will result in a \$150.00 replacement fee charged to the students account. If either of these fees are charged to a student account, the complimentary grad handshake photo will not be handed out until the fee is paid in full.

#### STUDENT FEES

As noted in the Graduation Policy Form that was required to be signed by all parents/guardians of grads, 'a student eligible to participate in the ceremony, the student fee accounts must be in good standing with the school.'

This payment must be made in full by May 15th. Any ceremony tickets not paid for by this time will be taken off your students account and made available to those on the waiting list. Photos not paid for will be removed from the students account.




#### PROPER PROCESS FOR SIGNING OUT OF SCHOOL
