New Login Process for Parents and Students in 2019/20

Parents, please be aware that Maplewood - our login system for accessing markbooks and attendance - will be discontinued at the end of this school year. Students and parents can access the Maplewood system to review final marks until July 5, 2019. A final report card will also be mailed home at the end of June.

Over the summer, student data will be transferred to our new online system called PowerSchool. Our desire is to have logins for parents and students at the end of August when registration commences; however, this may be delayed until the first or second week of September. 2019/2020 School Year

At WCHS, with the support of Wetaskiwin Early Education and Family Wellness Centre

Course Information:

This class is divided into five one credit courses. Each course has a practical component where individuals will observe and work with children under the age of five. Once all 5 courses have been completed, students will be eligible to receive a Child Development Assistant Certificate which enables students to work in a licensed day care, pre-school or out-of-school program.

Each Course should take approximately 35-40 hours to complete. This includes 10-12 hours per course at The Early Education and Family Wellness Center.
