I hope this newsletter finds all of our parents, students, and community members in good spirits and in good health. We are set to have a fantastic start to the 2019-2020 school year. This year, we have very little turnover in our staff which is comprised of 55 teachers and 20 support staff who are here to work with our 925 students. We are dedicated to providing our students with an amazing high school experience as we are focused on assisting students who need additional support and making sure our students are ready to graduate from WCHS within 4 years of entering Grade 9. This year our staff is once again focused on continuing the work of our High School Redesign initiative. With this work, we will be continuing with directed learning sessions on Tuesdays and Thursdays, as well as improving on the implementation of dual credit programming in our CTS courses. The Cosmetology Apprenticeship Program and our newly created Early Child Care course are examples of this.

At our School Council meetings each month, we will be reporting on the key strategies and initiatives that are taking place at WCHS. We will provide updates on how our programming is impacting our students and school as a whole. At this time, we will be welcoming feedback from our parents as we strive to provide the best possible learning environment for our students. REGISTRATION PACKAGES

POWERSCHOOL: Attendance & Grades

As announced back in June, WRPS has moved from Maplewood to PowerSchool for our Student Information system. PowerSchool offers a clean, intuitive interface and powerful tools and resources to help administrators and teachers manage grades, students and classrooms. As well, parents can check their child's homework assignments, attendance reports, grades and other items from any computer. We are thankful for our WRPS technical department who worked tirelessly to make this transition as smooth as possible.

POWERSCHOOL MOBILE APP

The PowerSchool app is available to parents and students to download for free from the App Store for the iPhone®, iPad® or iPod touch®, and Google Play for Android devices. Once you activate your account on a computer, you can log in to the app using your ID and the password that you created. You will also need to enter the District Code: **QMZX**. If you ever need this code for other devices in the future, you can find it on the bottom-left side of your login screen. 


SIGNING OUT PROCEDURE
