- > Strategic Plan is available online
- \$3.1 million deficit is incorrect due to, in part, insurance increase making the deficit

 \$3.3 million − looking for a solution to this
 - 306% increase in premiums
 - Using entire reserve to correct deficit this year
 - Jobs and classroom impact will be a no go until absolutely necessary
- Looking to create a partnership
 - in the next 4 years to make a larger impact on the community
 - making the school a community hub not just a school
- > There will be mid-year changes coming in January
- ➤ Anything that is being supplemented will be looked at as vulnerable

- How did it work having the report cards go online work for Parents?
- Things seem to have gone well, very few asked for a paper copy
- Paper copy will be printed for the student file at the school but no report cards will be sent home
- Looking to find a way for parents to print a report card from PowerSchool

- The mark book shows the marks broken into Q1 (quarter 1) and Q2 (quarter 2) as well as S1 (semester 1). S1 is the cumulative mark for Q1 and Q2 and shows the semester mark
- School Data
 - High School completion went up
 - Did not improve on the PATS
 - Diploma results were good
- > Accountability Pillar
 - Drop-out rate went down and is very low (high school completion)
 - ✓ We are below Provincial average for three-year completion
 - ✓ Fourth year we have a huge jump in completion
 - ✓ We will always have kids that need a fourth year to complete school
 - ✓ The goal is to get the three completion to 76%
 - Diploma marks are very good
 - ✓ Physics was 100% in acceptable once again this year
 - Parent involvement is good
 - PATS are not good
 - ✓ Dropped from 68% acceptable standard in 2018 to 63% in 2019
 - ✓ English dropped
 - o 6% drop
 - ✓ Math grades are low here and, in the Province,
 - We had an increase this year but is still low
 - Worked on the parts of the math curriculum that needed work and became more focussed on fundamentals in Math
 - ✓ Social dropped
 - o 4% drop
 - ✓ Science improved
 - ✓ We will continue to make the improvements that are needed

 - Letter will be going out November 25
 - Some classes may be cancelled or combined with other classes to make efficiencies
 - Will not make changes to classes offered year long
