With the school year quickly approaching, we are excited to finally see our students once again. We have lots of information ready for our students and parents as many changes have been implemented to make sure WCHS is ready to open. We have included information in this letter pertaining to our new bell schedule, students time tables and a description for each grade's staggered entry day. Remember that students only come on their designated day, and regular classes do not begin until Tuesday, September 8th. It is important that each student does attend their staggered entry day as we will be providing an orientation for each student and making sure each of our students has a great start to their school year.

Staggered Entry: Students will ONLY come to WCHS on the date listed below

** Please note if you are taking a course at a different grade level, please attend on the day that course is running (e.g. a Grade 12 student taking Physical Education 20, needs to attend school on Thursday, Sept 3rd).

- Students will be greeted at the Gym Entrance
- Students will be given their 2 reusable masks
- Students will be given their timetable and they will proceed to their first period classroom.
- Students will receive their textbooks for Q1
- Students will have an opportunity to make timetable changes throughout the day





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Grade 11: Thursday, September 3rd

- Students will be greeted at the Gym Entrance
- Students will be given their 2 reusable masks
- Students will be given their timetable and they will proceed to their first period classroom.
- Students will receive their textbooks for Q1
- Students will have an opportunity to make timetable changes throughout the day

Grade 10: Friday, September 4th

- Students will be greeted at the Band Room Entrance
- Students will be given their 2 reusable masks
- Students will be given their timetable and they will proceed to their first period classroom.

- Students will have an opportunity to make timetable changes throughout the day

Student Schedules

When entering the building

Students will have designated entrances and exits depending on their grade level. In the morning it is the expectation that students enter the building through their designated entrance and go directly to their first period class. Our buses will be performing two stops at different doors to accommodate these changes. Please note, students are not permitted on buses or in the school without a mask. Our school will not be open until 8:30 am





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and students are not permitted to congregate in any common areas or the hallways when they enter the building. Listed below is the designated entrance / exit for each grade.

- Grade 9 → Main Entrance (West Entrance)
- Grade 10 → Music Room Entrance (North West Entrance)
- Grade 11 / 12 → Gym Entrance (North East Entrance)
