- Looking for a graduate student willing to go to Ashoro to teach English and be liaison.
- Other Programs the Board is looking at implementing in the division:
 - o Drone program for High school (all 3 in division)
 - o Trade program focus like welding trucks and mobile trade units.
 - Oiler Hockey Programs

Question/Comment: Karen Elgert commented that the WCHS had drones, but that it was very expensive to insure - it was considered a terrorist risk. Interested to know how this will manifest. The drones at the high school have been laying dormant.
